**DEFENDANTS' FIRST SET OF INTERROGATORIES AND
DOCUMENT REQUESTS DIRECTED TO PLAINTIFF**

Pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 804.08 and 804.09, Defendants request that the State of Wisconsin ("Plaintiff") respond to the following Interrogatory and Request for Production (the "Discovery Requests") no later than 30 days from date of service. In an effort to limit the burden on Plaintiff and advance the efficient resolution of this litigation, Defendants have coordinated in propounding these Discovery Requests. By submitting joint Discovery Requests, Defendants do not intend to waive or limit each Defendant's right to propound additional discovery, whether joint or individual.

DEFINITIONS

1. "Wisconsin," "you" or "your" means the State of Wisconsin, including but not limited to the office of the Wisconsin Attorney General, the State of Wisconsin Department of Human Services, the State of Wisconsin Medicare Program, the State of Wisconsin Medicaid Program, any other Wisconsin Medical Assistance Program and any other Wisconsin agencies and programs.

2. The "Status Report" means the status report filed by the State of Wisconsin in the Dane County Circuit Court on October 5, 2005.

3. “Describe” means to describe fully by reference to underlying facts rather than by ultimate facts or conclusions of facts or law and to particularize as to time, place and manner

4. “Identify” when used in reference to a document, means to provide, to the extent know, information about (i) the type of document; (ii) its general subject matter; (iii) the date of the document; (iv) its author(s); and (v) each addressee.

5. “Identify” when use in reference to a person, means to provide, to the extent known, (i) the person or entity’s full name; (ii) present or last known address; (iii) phone number; and when referring to a natural person, (iv) the present or last known place of employment.

6. “Person” means any natural person or any business, legal, or governmental entity or association.

7. “And” and “or” shall be construed either disjunctively or conjunctively as necessary to bring within the scope of the request any information that might otherwise be construed to be outside its scope.

8. “Comprise” means referring to, describing, evidencing, or constituting.

9. “Refer” and “relate” means in any way consisting of or containing, showing, evidencing, relating or referring in any way, directly or indirectly, to, and is meant to include, among other documents, documents underlying, characterizing, supporting, now or previously attached or appended to, or used in the preparation of any document called for by each request

10. “Document” means the original and each non-identical copy of a document in any medium, including electronic form, whether or not it was communicated to any person other than the author, including but not limited to, writings, printouts, printings, photo-graphs, photocopies, tapes, recordings, video recordings, electronic data, e-mails, and any other symbolic representations in your possession, custody, or control or known or believed by you to exist.

11. "Defendants" means the Defendants identified in the First Amended Complaint that have entered unqualified appearances in this action.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unless otherwise specifically stated, the requests below refer to the time period of January 1, 1993 to the present.

2. Each request for production of documents extends to all documents in your possession, custody, or control or anyone acting on your behalf. A document is to be deemed in your possession, custody, or control if it is in your physical custody, or if it is in the physical custody of any other person and you (a) own such document in whole or in part; (b) have a right, by contract, statute, or otherwise, to use, inspect, examine, or copy such document on any terms; (c) have an understanding, express or implied, that you may use, inspect, examine or copy such document on any terms; or (d) have, as a practical matter, been able to use, inspect, examine, or copy such document when you sought to do so.

3. If production is requested of a document that is no longer in your possession, custody, or control, your response should state when the document was most recently in your possession, custody, or control, how the document was disposed of, and the identity of the person, if any, presently in possession, custody, or control of such document. If the document has been destroyed, state the reason for its destruction.

4. Provide the following information for each document withheld on the grounds of privilege:

- (a) its date;
- (b) its title;
- (c) its author;
- (d) its addressee;
- (e) the specific privilege under which it is withheld;

(f) its general subject matter; and

(g) a description of it that you contend is adequate to support your contention that it is privileged.

5. Pursuant to the Wisconsin Rules of Civil Procedure, these requests for documents are continuing in nature so as to require, whenever necessary, continuing production and supplementation of responses between the initial date for production set forth above and the end of trial.

6. To the extent that you consider any of the following requests for production of documents objectionable, please respond to the remainder of the production request, and separately state the part of each request to which you object and each ground for each objection.

INTERROGATORY

INTERROGATORY NO. 1:

With respect to your representation in the Status Report that you have “evidence that the manufacturers caused phony and inflated wholesale prices to be published with respect to each of the listed drugs,” on the list of drugs attached to the Status Report (attached hereto as Exhibit A):

(a) Describe such evidence with respect to each defendant and each drug; and

(b) Identify all persons with knowledge of such evidence with respect to each defendant and each drug.

REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS

REQUEST NO. 1:

All documents relied upon in connection with your response to Interrogatory No. 1 or that otherwise comprise, refer or relate to your evidence that each defendant “caused phony and inflated wholesale prices to be published with respect to each of the listed drugs” set forth on the list of drugs attached to the Status Report (attached hereto as Exhibit A).



PLAINTIFF STATE OF WISCONSIN'S STATUS REPORT

Plaintiff submits the following status report to bring the Court up to date on developments occurring subsequent to the parties' last court appearance.

1. This case has been remanded to state court. Attached is the opinion of Judge Crabb remanding the case, finding that defendants' removed this case in derogation of settled law, and awarding plaintiff its fees and costs.
2. Since our last court appearance plaintiff has supplied each of the defendants with a list of targeted drugs which significantly reduced the number of drugs for which plaintiff currently seeks relief. (Defendants complained to the Court about the fact that the Complaint alleges that they inflated the wholesale prices of all their drugs and requested that plaintiff narrow its request from the 65,000 possible NDC numbers in existence. Although plaintiff stands by its allegation that all of defendants' wholesale prices were inflated, plaintiff created this list to simplify the initial rounds of discovery.) Plaintiff has evidence that defendants caused phony and inflated wholesale prices to be published with respect to each of the listed drugs and Wisconsin's purchases of each of the drugs based on defendants' inflated prices was substantial. This list of targeted drugs is attached.

3. None of the defendants has meaningfully responded to plaintiff's discovery requests, even though defendants' task was reduced by the targeted drug list. Most of the defendants have raised sweeping objections to virtually all of plaintiff's discovery. Pursuit of these defendants was, unfortunately, delayed by defendants' unauthorized removal. By law, plaintiff could not pursue any discovery while the case was in federal court without waiving its objection to removal. As a result, plaintiff is only now able to file a number of motions to compel against the most seriously recalcitrant defendants. Simultaneously, plaintiff is seeking meet and confer conferences with other defendants to give them an additional opportunity to respond appropriately to plaintiff's discovery.
